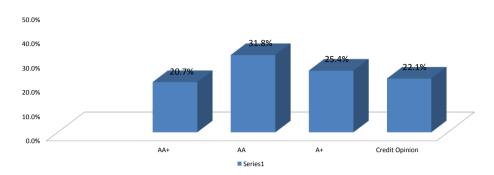

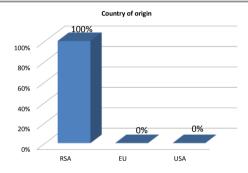

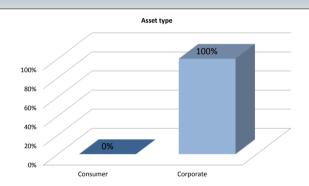
#### Credit concentration analysis



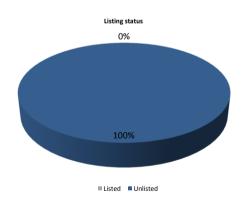

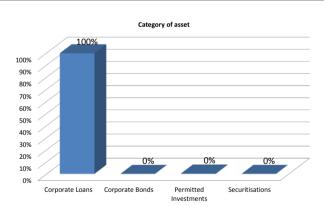
## Asset origination (based on accreted value)





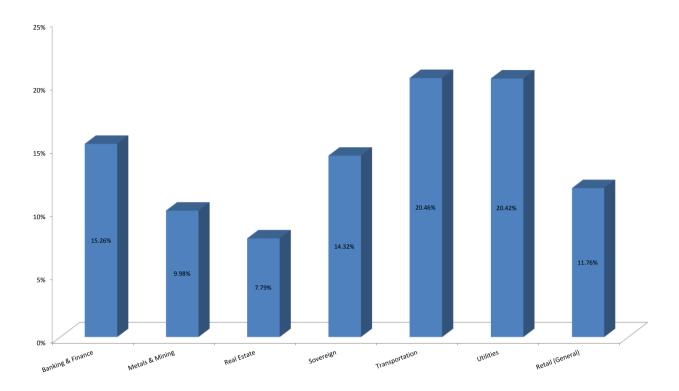
## Asset category analysis (based on accreted value)
